

She took part in the foundation of a children television channel called Minimax, for which she has been working as a Programming Director since 1999. Together with colleagues from Canal+ she prepared the launching of Minimax. Among her tasks she was responsible for the structure of the program, the annual program plan, program acquisition, marketing strategy and brand building. She was the producer, creative and co-producer of different TV programs: Minimax News - monthly TV magazine, Nursery Rhymes - animated series, Staraoke - music quizshow, Bombi P.E. - P.E. program for children. During the last few years this TV channel has been developed significantly. Right now Minimax broadcasts its programs not only in Hungary but in Romania, Czech Republic, Slovakia, and in the states of former Yugoslavia (except Slovenia).

Regular attendant of TV markets (MIPTV, MIPCOM, DISCOP) and children's program festivals and conferences (Cartoon Forum, Kidscreen) both in Hungary and abroad. And also she often takes part in projects dealing with the relationship between children and the television p.e.: Media Smart program.

In 2007 the Liberty Global Chellomedia bought Minimax together with other thematic channels. Since then she is the Acquisition and Programming Director of other channels as well: Deko, Filmmúzeum, Minimax, Spektrum and TV Paprika.
